CODE OF CONDUCT FOR COACHES/MANAGERS/PARENTS/SPECTATORS AND PLAYERS

All members of BJFC are reminded of the F.A. regulations regarding behaviour at all matches. This refers to all Parents, Spectators and Club Officials on the touchline as well as the Players on the field of play.

The Referee is in charge of all persons attending from the moment he or she arrives at the ground and until he or she leaves.

RULE 4, CLAUSE C (Brislington Constitution)

THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO SUSPEND OR EXPEL ANY MEMBER DEEMED GUILTY OF CONDUCT PREJUDICIAL TO THE GOOD OF THE CLUB.

Coaches, Managers, Parents and Spectators.

You are reminded that you **MUST** refrain from entering the field of play whilst the game is in motion, no matter what the circumstances.

Please let the Referee deal with all situations.

Would you also keep comments about the Referee and his Assistants to yourselves no matter how badly you may think he/she or they are performing.

Coaches, Managers, Parents and Spectators reported for any type of abuse i.e. verbal, physical or bullying shall be banned by this club from watching Football matches involving this club and will be reported to the relevant League(s).

Players

Any player sent off for physical abuse i.e. punching, kicking, spitting or verbal abuse i.e. swearing at the Referee his assistant or an opponent – RULE 4, CLAUSE C, will come into effect from the day that the incident occurs.

The Player will be banned from playing for this club.

Coaches, Managers, Players, Parents and all spectators will be deemed to be aware of, understand and agree to adhere to these conditions when watching Brislington Juniors F.C.
